

ETTA APPROVED LAWS OF TABLE TENNIS

Letter from Alex Murdoch dated 11th August 2009 saying local league players can use any type of rubber that complies with the requirements of the Laws in respect of thickness, colour etc, whether or not it is a type currently authorised by the ITTF.

League rules for players to use only racket coverings that are authorised by the ITTF cannot be made compulsory and should be regarded as a recommendation or request.

2.4 THE RACKET

2.4.6 The surface of the covering material on a side of the blade, or of a side of the blade if it is left uncovered, shall be matt, bright red on one side and black on the other.

2.4.7 The racket covering should be used as it has been authorised without any physical, chemical or other treatment, (except normal wear) - changing or modifying playing properties, friction, outlook, colour, structure etc.
